

**LIVING HISTORY at MURTON PARK:
COVID19 RISK MANAGEMENT STATEMENT.**

All the Murton Park team are fully committed to ensuring that all our visiting schools have a safe and enjoyable visit and an effective learning experience. During the current pandemic situation, additional measures are in place to minimise the risk of infection and we ask schools to be aware that there may be some changes to the way in which your visit will operate. These measures are under constant review to reflect government guidelines and specific experience.

We would ask schools to note that we are an independent organisation making huge efforts to provide a safe and fun learning environment in the current situation. This has significant cost implications for our organisation. To ensure our survival, we are asking that schools keep us informed of their plans and give a firm commitment to visits as soon as possible in order to help us plan.

1) Our Staff:

Our staff are subject to health monitoring and have received additional training to help ensure safety for themselves and visiting groups. Each visiting group will have its own dedicated team of our staff who will not be working with any other groups or mixing with other staff other than where essential for the running of the day.

2) Our Site:

Our buildings are thoroughly cleaned before and after each day and are subject to spot cleaning in high traffic areas throughout the day.

Additional toilet and sterilising stations will be available as required to avoid the sharing of facilities.

Additional cleaning materials will be available to help schools comply with any of their own procedures which may be relevant.

During the day, instruction will be given by members of our staff either socially distancing or using face visors and other appropriate ppe. Please note, we cannot provide ppe for members of staff of you group.

Wherever possible children will not be sharing equipment. All common use equipment will be cleaned between use. We would appreciate help and support from visiting staff with this task.
